Payments to school - Please note all payments for dinner money, breakfast club and afterschool club must be paid in advance via School Gateway, many thanks to all our parents who are already using this regularly.

Classroom Drop-In for Y2, Y3 and Y5 will take place this afternoon. All other children to be collected from their usual exits.

Reading and homework – Children from Y1 to 6 will be given reading books this week, please read with your children every day if possible. Reading books and reading records must be brought to school every day, whether the children have read or not (adults in school will listen to children in school). Homework will begin next week.

Afterschool Activity Clubs – will begin again next week. These are clubs to enable children to socialise and enjoy the activities. Please don't use them as free afterschool childcare. I.e. please don't send your child to a club without asking them whether it is something they want to participate in. It ruins the atmosphere for everyone if there are children in an afterschool group who don't want to participate. It also affects the goodwill of the staff who voluntarily give up their own time to run these clubs.

Please sign up via the google forms below. Due to having more children than places, each child is allowed to apply for 2 clubs only. We will pull names from a hat to allocate places and then let you know by the end of tomorrow whether or not your child has been accepted into a club.
